GEOGRAPHICAL AND GEOPOLITICAL LOCATION



Murmansk is the biggest city beyond the Polar Circle, the largest Russian sea transport hub and fishing centre, which has a leading position in the region's economy and remains its financial, business and cultural centre.

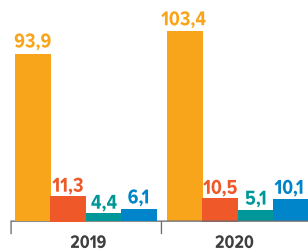

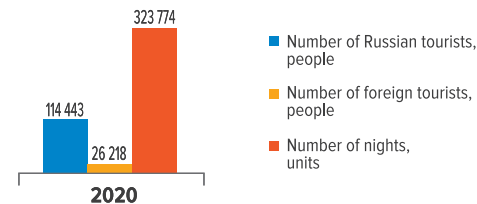
